## Code of Conduct

### Roles of Coach/Manager

- Organise team matters - team selection, training and equipment.
- To be reliable, punctual, and show consistency.
- Ensure players understand the laws of the game.
- To take charge of team disciplines and encourage self-discipline in players.
- To encourage sportsmanship and be a positive role model.
- To follow and adhere to the clubs policies including Equality, Health & Safety, Data Protection & Safeguarding policies.

### Roles of the Player

- Play to the best of ability and in the spirit of the game.
- Respect the Coach, Officials and Opposition.
- Show commitment including reliability and punctuality.
- To show self-discipline with language and behaviour.
- Be prepared to learn, improve and enjoy the game.

### Role of Parents/Adults/Supporters

- Assist in transporting players to training and matches when necessary.
- Help and support the coach, coaches, team and players if appropriate.
- A positive role in terms of language, attitude, restraint and sportsmanship.
- Show respect to officials and opposition.
- Use positive comments only - encourage not discourage.
- There must be no;
  1. Unacceptable adult involvement.
  2. Verbal abuse and negative comments.
  3. Entering the field of play.
  4. Obscene or discriminatory language including racism.
  5. Arguing with officials or the oppositions supporters.
  6. Supporting bad behaviour by players.
  7. Interfering in the Coach's role.
